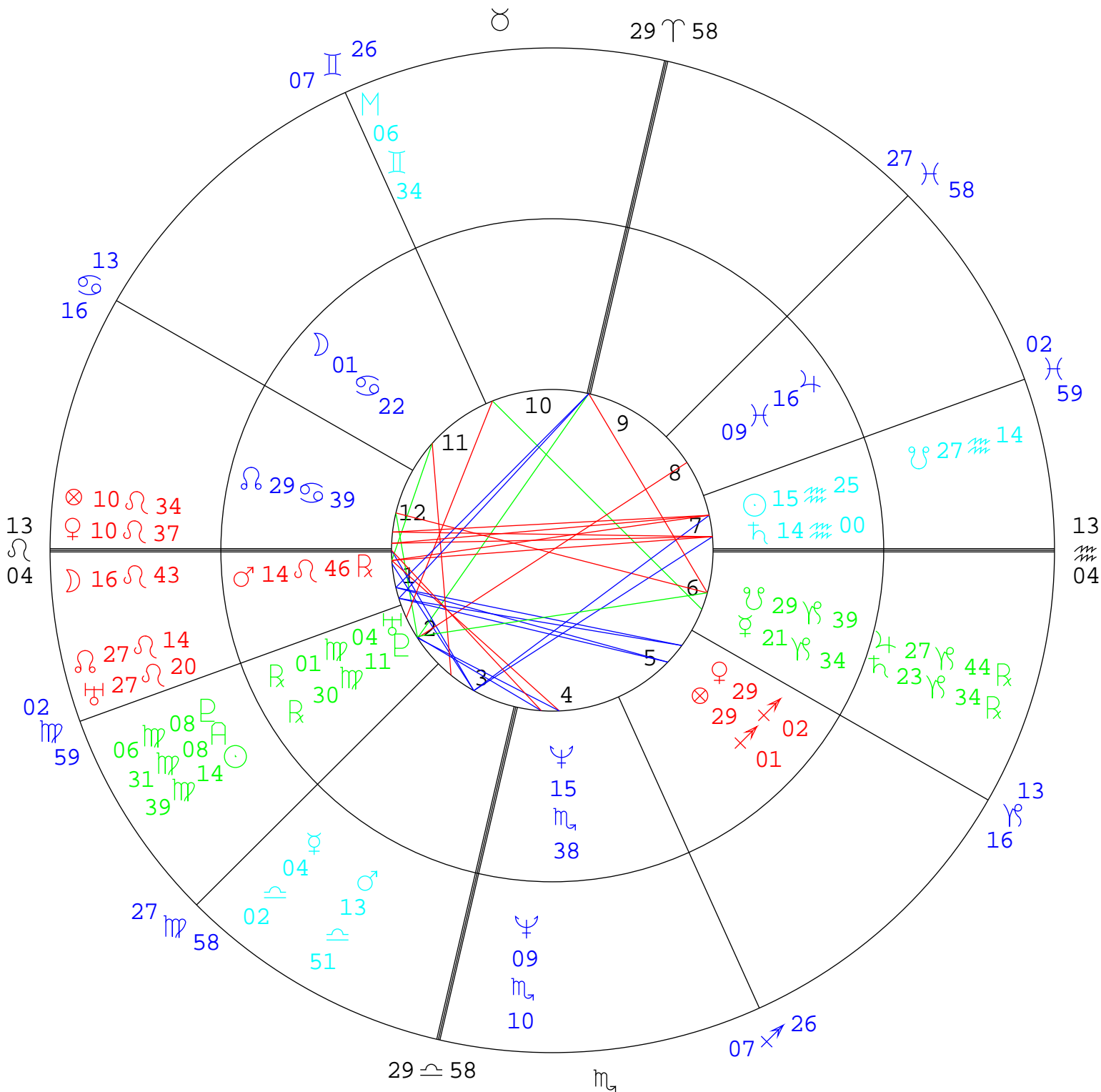

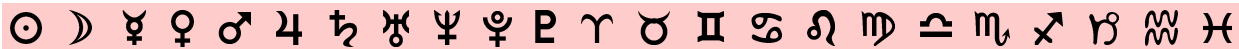

**Sun opposite Moon Orb 1°18'**

One of you easily assumes the dominant role (Sun) in the relationship; and the partner is willingly supportive as long as emotional needs are satisfied. But if the dominant partner is too self-centered, irrational behavior can disrupt harmony.

**Sun trine Mars Orb 1°34'**

You have the ability to energize each other and, when moving in the same direction, can be an unbeatable team. If there is disagreement, however, it can lead to angry confrontation. Dissolve the impass by energetically working to compromise.

**Moon square Mercury Orb 2°40'**

Intuition may be strong between you, so that you sometimes know what the other is thinking before words are expressed. But to avoid misreading each other it might be a good idea to verbalize, especially when emotional issues are involved.

**Mercury conjunct Saturn Orb 2°0'**

**Venus trine North Node Orb 1°48'**

Excellent combination for socializing--not only enjoying the company of others, but taking pleasure in being together as well. Avoid over-indulging your fun-loving side (Venus) to the detriment of all else, if you want a well-founded partnership.

**Mars conjunct Moon Orb 1°57'**

Emotions will probably be energetically expressed in your relationship. As you undoubtedly know, it is definitely beneficial to get feelings out of your system, but whether you do this lovingly or in outbursts of anger is up to you.

**Mars conjunct Venus Orb 4°9'**

Attraction between you can be very strong, with one of you being more the aggressor (Mars) and the other the recipient (Venus). If, however, the aggressor becomes too forceful the partner may want to look elsewhere for pleasure.

**Mars sextile Mars Orb 0°55'**

Your energy level will be high when your efforts are combined. Much can be accomplished if you work in harmony. But, if disagreements arise, direct energies elsewhere to avoid open conflict, because who wants to be the first to give in?

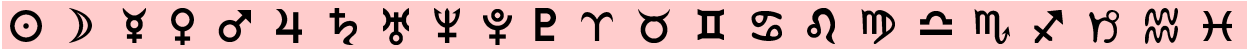
